### 2020 BRAUNEBERGER JUFFER SONNENUHR 'IM FALKENBERG' VDP.GROSSES GEWÄCHS

The auction GG was grown on a notably stony section of the Juffer Sonnenuhr known as 'Im Falkenberg.' Situated directly along the banks of the Mosel and strewn with slate cliffs, this unique microclimate is home and haven to vines up to 80 years of age, many ungrafted. Hand harvesting these small, highly aromatic grapes from this steep parcel is a massive undertaking, and the resulting volumes are very small. Our 'Im Falkenberg' GG is raised 100% in wood casks, drawing out its minerality, dark slate spice and a concentrated, yellow fruit character. Based on the deep concentration and perfect acidity, the ripening potential is enormous. Only minute volumes of this wine are available.



### 2020 BRAUNEBERGER JUFFER SONNENUHR RIESLING KABINETT

We don't always get the chance to produce a Kabinett wine from our crown jewel parcel on the Brauneberger Juffer Sonnenuhr, as the conditions of the vintage must be perfect. But when they do fall into place... the one-of-a-kind microclimate created by the cliffs on the Sonnenuhr, taken together with the strong share of blue slate, lend themselves to an extraordinary Kabinett. It is the quintessence of refreshing sweetness, establishing a beautiful balance through its filigreed, light-footed acidity and spicy, chiseled slate aromatics. Its transparency and lightness radiate through its deep and complex fruits: A Kabinett for the ages!



### 2020 BRAUNEBERGER JUFFER SONNENUHR RIESLING SPÄTLESE #14

This Spätlese comes from one of the finest sections of the Brauneberger Juffer Sonnenuhr. The vines grow on notably barren soil, with a strong share of blue slate and roots running deep in the water-retaining cliffs below. A high-class Spätlese from a vintage that is seemingly predestined for cellarable naturally sweet wines. The minimalist grace and unforgettable finesse of this Sonnenuhr Spätlese are borne on the wings of a racy, ultra-delicate acidity.
